REMITTED PART OF THE LEEDS SITE ALLOCATIONS PLAN 2024 Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) notice is hereby given that Leeds City Council adopted the Remitted Part of the Site Allocations Plan (here after referred to as the Remitted Part of the Plan) on 17th January 2024.

A number of modifications were made to the Site Allocation Plan 2019 pursuant to section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (the Act). These are set out in the Inspectors' Report.

Any person aggrieved by the Remitted Part of the Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Act on the grounds that:

- i. the Remitted Part of the Plan is not within the powers conferred by Part 2 of the Act;
- ii. a procedural requirement of the Act or its associated Regulations has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made promptly and, in any event, before the end of 29 February 2024 being the period of six weeks beginning with the date after the adoption of the Plan.
