

arts@leeds grant scheme FAQs

1. What does 'new organisations' mean?

A 'new' organisation means that they haven't received funding from arts@leeds before. All new organisations must have an arts@leeds funding surgery before they are eligible to apply.

2. Is an individual's past experience with other arts organisations relevant as past successes?

Yes this evidence can be used as experience of past success.

3. Can other Leeds City Council funding be counted towards the 10% match funding?

Yes it can be counted.

4. What activity are the KPIs relate to?

The KPIs are based on the entire annual work of the company

5. What do you mean by 'session'?

The day is divided into three sessions, morning, afternoon and evening as follows:

One morning, or part of a morning, is one session

One afternoon, or part of an afternoon, is one session

One evening, or part of an evening, is one session.

6. What does it mean in Section 6 where it says If the budget does not balance, you will be ineligible for funding?

It means that we will not accept a deficit budget, the organisation will have to have a 'profit' for the year to create a surplus to put into their reserves, not every penny has to be spent.

7. Outcomes

When completing section 5, please note the total number of sessions listed on 5.1 should be the same as the total number of sessions on 5.4 for each year.

8. What is a 'targeted session'?

Section 5.1 - please do not double count your sessions, the 'targeted group' is the primary target group, for example older people. Only put down men or women if you are specifically targeting this group and not their age or ethnicity.
