



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

◆ Introduction

The Waterfront Strategy is the key document to guide the regeneration of the Leeds waterfront. It was developed by a unique partnership of Leeds City Council, British Waterways, the Environment Agency, Leeds Civic Trust and Eye on the Aire (now disbanded). It was adopted by the Leeds Initiative in 2002 and also by Leeds City Council as Supplementary Guidance.

In the three years since adoption, much has changed. A number of related studies have been completed and many developments have taken place on the ground. The Partial Review of the Waterfront Strategy has made a few minor amendments to the document to reflect the above and make it more user friendly. This partial review will ensure that the document remains influential for the next three years during which a full review of the document will take place.
