CITY CENTRE AREA ACTION PLAN DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT (DPD)

Leeds City Council is proposing to make the City Centre Area Action Plan Development Plan Document (DPD) relating to the future development of Leeds city centre. As part of this process it has produced a Preferred Options document and Sustainability Appraisal report and is seeking representations on these proposals.
