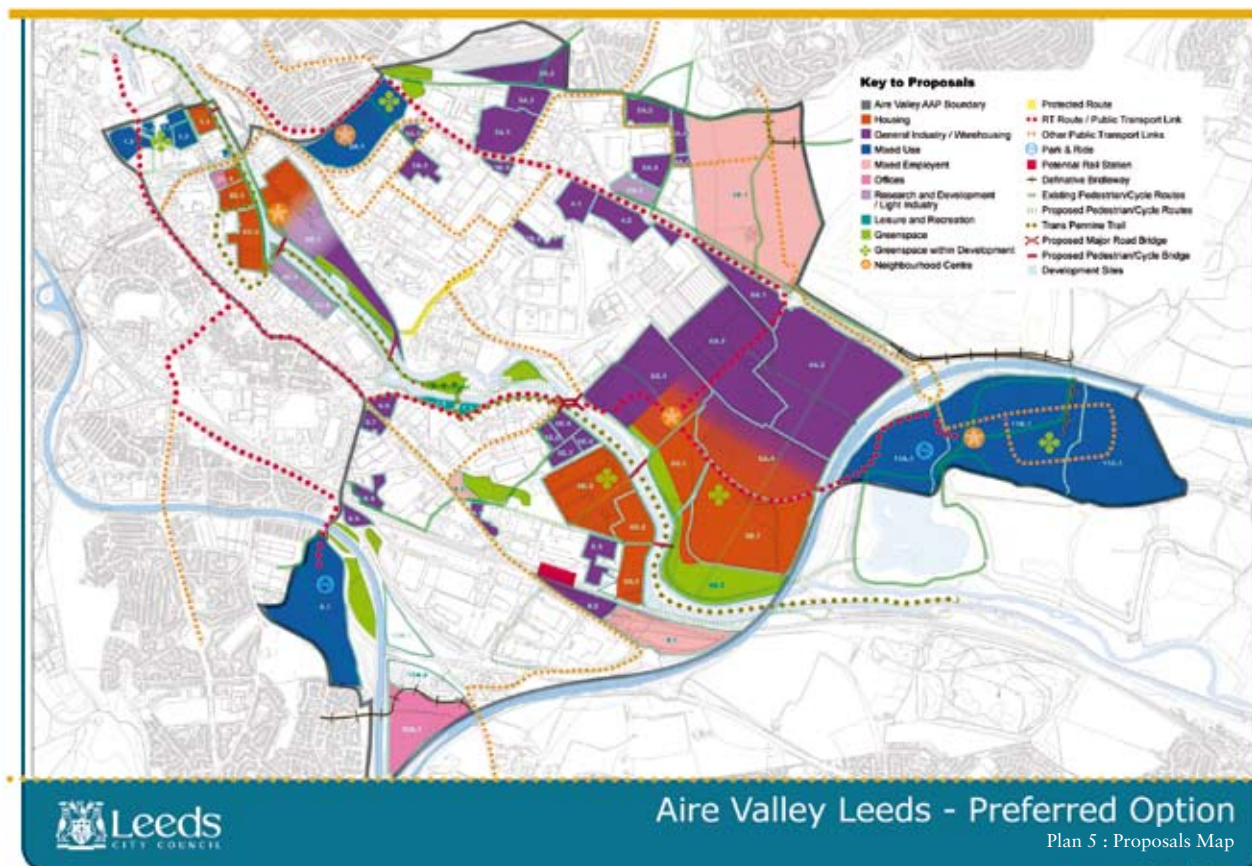

What will the plan propose?

- Enough employment land to deliver 27,000 new jobs to the area.
- Up to 7,000 new houses, including family and affordable housing.
- New facilities, including new schools, shops and health facilities.
- Public transport that allows the movement of people and goods in/out and around Aire Valley Leeds.
- New recreational opportunities around the river/canal corridor.
- Investment in training and skills and child care facilities, to ensure local communities benefit from the new opportunities.
- Maximising the development of some 250 hectares of derelict and contaminated land.
- Environmental improvements, such as improving the odour problem associated with Knostrop waste water treatment works.
