



BIODIVERSITY AND WATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT (SPD)

ADOPTION STATEMENT

The Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) for Biodiversity and Waterfront Development was adopted by Leeds City Council on 20 December 2006. The Biodiversity and Waterfront Development SPD provides a framework to inform, guide and assess new development on sites adjacent to rivers, canals and becks in Leeds to ensure that biodiversity issues are fully considered and addressed.

Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
