PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Leeds City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1, 2 and 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1 For the purposes of this Order "**motor vehicle**" shall have the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act
- 2 No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order
- 3 The Chief Highways Officer of the Council is hereby empowered to modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it if it appears to him essential
 - 3.1 in the interests of the expeditious convenient and safe movement of traffic
 - 3.2 in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities; or
 - 3.3 for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runsin accordance with the provisions of Sections 9 to 11 inclusive of the 1984 Act
- 4 The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment

- 5 For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it
- 6 This Order is made on the *22nd* day of *December* 2008 and shall come into effect of the *5th* day of *January* 2009 and may be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Movement Restrictions) (No.M12) (Experimental) Order 2008"
