Gipton & South Seacroft Intensive Neighbourhood Management Area

Some key things to note across the area as a whole

- Generally an improving picture across the area with 5 out of the 8 SOAs in this area seeing an improvement in their Index of Multiple Deprivation rankings
- In 2004 every SOA in the area was ranked in the 3% most deprived nationally on the Index of Multiple Deprivation, 2 SOAs have now seen their Index of Multiple Deprivation improve sufficiently to lift them out of this bracket
- Perhaps the most notable improvements have been seen in the Income and Living Environment Deprivation domains where every SOA in the area has improved its ranking

Some key things to note within individual SOAs

E01011339: Oaktrees / Beech Mount Oakwood Lane

- Although its Index of Multiple Deprivation ranking has improved from 409 in 2004 to 931 in 2007 this SOA remains in the most deprived 3% nationally
- Its rankings have improved in every domain except Crime where it has fallen very slightly from 270 in 2004 to 259 in 2007
- Improvements in the Education and Living Environment domain rankings have, in both cases, been sufficient to lift it out of the 3% most deprived nationally, while an improved ranking in the Income domain has moved it from the 10% to the 20% bracket

E01011342: Brander Road / South Farms / Coldcotes

- An improvement of 486 places has seen this SOA move from a rank of 585 in 2004 to 1,071 in 2007, lifting from the 3% to the 10% bracket on the Index of Multiple Deprivation
- Perhaps the most notable improvement has been in the Living Environment domain where its ranking has improved by over 3,000 places lifting it beyond the 20% threshold
- The SOA remains in the most deprived 3% nationally in both the Education and Crime domains, and with a rank of 16 in the Crime domain is the city's most deprived SOA in this respect

E01011346: Wykebeck Valley Road / Branders / Gipton Approach

- This SOA has seen a slight fall in its Index of Multiple Deprivation ranking and remains in the most deprived 3% on the national scale
- It has also seen its ranking fall across five other domains
- Changes in the rankings have not moved the SOA beyond the 3%, 10% and 20% brackets it occupied in 2004

E01011427: Easterly Grove / St Wilfrids

- An improvement of 586 places has seen this SOA move from a rank of 820 in 2004 to 1,406 in 2007, lifting from the 3% to the 10% bracket on the Index of Multiple Deprivation
- Its rankings have improved in every domain except Income Deprivation Affecting Older People where it has fallen slightly from 1,018 in 2004 to 960 in 2007, meaning that it is now ranked in the most deprived 3% nationally
- While its rankings have improved in both the Crime and Living Environment domains it remains in the most deprived 3% nationally in both cases, however an improved ranking in the Education domain has seen the SOA lifted from the 3% bracket into the 10%

E01011431: Foundrys / Thorn Drive / North Farm Road

- Although its Index of Multiple Deprivation ranking has improved from 263 in 2004 to 314 in 2007 this SOA remains in the most deprived 3% nationally
- An improvement of 490 places in the Income Deprivation domain has seen it lifted from the 3% bracket into the 10%
- The SOA remains in the most deprived 3% nationally in the Education, Crime and Living Environment domains and a fall in the Health Deprivation and Disability domain ranking has also seen it fall into the most deprived 3% in this respect

E01011662: Foundry Mill Terrace / Brooklands

- With a rank of 224 (3 places lower than in 2004) this SOA remains in the 3% most deprived nationally on the Index of Multiple Deprivation
- Perhaps the most notable improvement has been in the Living Environment domain where an improvement of over 1,500 places has lifted the SOA from the 3% bracket into the 10%
- A fall of 537 places in the Employment Deprivation ranking has seen it drop from the 10% into the 3% bracket, while a fall of over 2,700 places in Income Deprivation Affecting Older People has seen it drop into the 20% most deprived on the national scale

E01011663: Tarnside Drive / Foundry Mill Street / South Parkway

- Although its Index of Multiple Deprivation ranking has improved from 78 in 2004 to 249 in 2007 this SOA remains in the most deprived 3% nationally
- Its rankings have improved in every domain except Education where it has remained static and Crime where it has fallen slightly from 416 in 2004 to 325 in 2007
- The SOA is ranked the 4th most deprived in the country in the Education, Skills and Training Deprivation domain, making it the most deprived in the city in this respect
- Perhaps the most notable improvement has been in the Living Environment domain where an improvement of over 2,800 places has lifted the SOA from the 3% bracket into the 10%

E01011667: Foundry Mill Drive / Hawkshead Crescent / Alston Lane

- This SOA has seen a slight fall in its Index of Multiple Deprivation ranking from 275 in 2004 to 127 in 2007 and remains in the most deprived 3% nationally
- It has also seen its ranking fall across five other domains, and is ranked in the most deprived 3% nationally across every domain except Health and Living Environment where it is ranked in the most deprived 10% bracket
- The most notable improvement has been in the Living Environment domain where the ranking has improved by over 1,700 places, from 282 in 2004 to 2,010 in 2007 lifting it from the 3% bracket into the 10%
