Burmantofts and Richmond Hill Intensive Neighbourhood Management Area

Some key things to note across the area as a whole

- Generally an improving picture across the area as a whole with the majority of SOAs improving their rankings across most domains
- Only 3 of the 11 SOAs that are covered (either in whole or in part) by this INM area have seen a fall in their Index of Multiple Deprivation rankings
- Crime continues to be an issue with 6 out of the 11 SOAs seeing their rankings in this domain fall
- Similarly, in the Income Deprivation Affecting Children 6 out of 11 SOAs have seen their rankings fall

Some key things to note within individual SOAs

E01011338: Haselwoods / Rigtons

- While this SOA is still ranked in the most deprived 3% nationally on the Index of Multiple Deprivation, it has improved across most domains, the two exceptions being Crime and Income Deprivation Affecting Children
- In 2004 the area was ranked in the most deprived 3% nationally in five other domains – with the improvement in rankings for 2007 the SOA only remains in the 3% bracket only in the Employment Deprivation domain – however the fall in ranking in the Crime domain has seen the SOA fall from the 10% bracket into the most deprived 3%v in this domain also
- Perhaps the most notable improvement has been in the Education, Skills an Training domain where an improvement of 2,375 places (from 875 in 2004 to 3,250 in 2007) lifting it from the 3% bracket into the 20%

E01011348: Torres

- In 2004 this SOA was ranked in the most deprived 3% nationally on the Index of Multiple Deprivation – its improved ranking in 2007 lifts it out of this bracket although it still remains in the most deprived 10% on the national scale
- The SOA has improved its rankings across every element of the Indices of Deprivation except the Employment Deprivation where it has fallen slightly from 2,783 in 2004 to 2,565 in 2007
- Although the rankings have generally improved this has not been sufficient to move the SOA beyond the 3%, 10% and 20% brackets it occupied in 2004

E01011617: Rookwoods (N.B. only part of this SOA is contained in the INM area)

- This SOA has seen a slight fall in its Index of Multiple Deprivation ranking from 2,309 in 2004 to 2,136 in 2007, and is still ranked in the 10% most deprived on the national scale
- The SOA has also seen its rankings fall in 5 other domains, although this has only impacted on the Employment Deprivation domain where it has fallen into the most deprived 10% nationally
- The SOA remains in the most deprived 3% nationally in the Education, Skills and Training Deprivation domain
- Perhaps the most notable improvement has been in the Living Environment domain where the ranking has improved by 3,418 places from 2,997 in 2004 to 6,415 in 2007 lifting it from the 10% bracket into the 20%

E01011618: Dawlish Ave / Vinerys / Ecclesburns (N.B. only part of this SOA is contained in the INM area)

- An improvement of over 1,100 places has seen this SOA move beyond the 20% threshold on the Index of Multiple Deprivation making it the least deprived of the 11 SOAs in this INM area
- The SOA has improved its rankings across every element of the Indices of Deprivation except Health where it has fallen slightly from 10,569 in 2004 to 10,077 in 2007
- The SOA is ranked above the 20% threshold in most domains, the only exceptions being Living Environment where it is ranked in the most deprived 3% and Education, Skills and Training where it is ranked in the most deprived 10% nationally

E01011619: East St / Upper Accommodation Rd / Lavender Street (N.B. only part of this SOA is contained in the INM area)

- While this SOA is still ranked in the most deprived 10% nationally on the Index of Multiple Deprivation, it has improved across most domains, the two exceptions being Crime and Income Deprivation Affecting Children
- Although the rankings have generally improved this has not been sufficient to move the SOA beyond the 3%, 10% and 20% brackets it occupied in 2004, although the fall in the ranking in Income Deprivation Affecting Children means it has dropped into the most deprived 3% nationally

E01011621: Ings Road / Nevilles / Osmondthorpe Lane (N.B. only part of this SOA is contained in the INM area)

- While this SOA is still ranked in the most deprived 10% nationally on the Index of Multiple Deprivation, it has improved across most domains, the two exceptions being Crime and Income Deprivation Affecting Children
- Although the rankings have generally improved this has not been sufficient to move the SOA beyond the 3%, 10% and 20% brackets it occupied in 2004
- The SOA remains in the most deprived 3% nationally in the Education, Skills and Training Deprivation domain

E01011622: Neville Road / Wykebecks

- A generally worsening position with rankings falling in the Index of Multiple Deprivation and in 6 other domains
- The worsening rankings in Employment, Crime and Income Deprivation Affecting Children have seen the SOA fall into the most deprived 3% nationally
- The only notable improvement has been in the Living Environment domain where an improvement of over 5,000 places has seen the SOA move beyond the 20% threshold

E01011623: East Park Drive / Glensdales / Raincliffes

- While this SOA is still ranked in the most deprived 10% nationally on the Index of Multiple Deprivation, it has improved across most domains, the only exception being Crime domain where the ranking has fallen slightly from 299 in 2004 to 268 in 2007
- While the picture is improving generally the SOA remains in the most deprived 3% nationally in the Crime and Living Environment domains

E01011625: St Hildas / Copperfields / Gartons (N.B. only part of this SOA is contained in the INM area)

- While Its Index of Multiple Deprivation ranking has improved slightly the SOA remains in the most deprived 20% on the national scale
- Although the picture is generally positive there has been a notable fall in the rankings in the Income and Employment Deprivation domains, and the SOA remains in the most deprived 3% nationally in the Living Environment domain

E01011626: Cross Green Lane / Easy Road / Dial Street / Dent Street (N.B. only part of this SOA is contained in the INM area)

- The SOA has seen a slight fall in its Index of Multiple Deprivation ranking and remains in the most deprived 3% nationally
- Rankings have also fallen in 5 other domains and the SOA is ranked in the most deprived 3% nationally for Income Deprivation (including Income Deprivation Affecting Children), Employment, Education, Skills & Training, and Crime

E01011675: Lincoln Green (N.B. only part of this SOA is contained in the INM area)

- While this SOA is still ranked in the most deprived 3% nationally on the Index of Multiple Deprivation, it has improved across most domains, the two exceptions being Living Environment and Income Deprivation Affecting Older People
- The fall in the Living Environment ranking means that the area has dropped from the 10% bracket into the most deprived 3% nationally
- The most notable improvements have been in the Income, Health and Crime domains where improved rankings have lifted the area out of the most deprived 3% bracket
