**AMENDMENT OF EXISTING PARKING PLACES ORDER**

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1, 2, 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and in pursuance of the powers contained in Section 73 and Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Leeds City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2005 shall have effect as though in the First Schedule thereto there was included the off-street parking place described in the First Schedule to this Order
2. This Order is made on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of April 2009 and shall come into effect on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 2009 and may be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2005 (Amendment) (No.2) Order 2009"
