STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

A new High School has been built to replace the old school on the same site. The new school will have a pedestrian entrance for pupils off Lingfield Approach.

As part of a scheme of highway works, an informal pedestrian crossing is to be constructed on Lingfield Approach adjacent to the new pedestrian entrance.

In anticipation of visibility problems being created by parents dropping off and picking up pupils when this entrance comes into use, this Order prohibits stopping on the entrance markings at school start and finish times.

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to introduce no stopping between 8.00am to 9.00am and 3.00pm to 4.00pm Monday to Friday inclusive on the school entrance markings on the northern side of Lingfield Approach from a point 5 metres east of its junction with the projected south-western kerbline of Lingfield View in an easterly direction for a distance of 43 metres.

Full details of the proposals in the form of a draft Order together with a plan showing the affected section of highway and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing and Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1 and at Moor Allerton Library, Moor Allerton Centre, Leeds 17.

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and in pursuance of the powers contained in Section 73 and Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1 No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to stop wait or otherwise leave the vehicle in a stationary manner between 8.00am to 9.00am and 3.00pm to 4.00pm on Monday to Friday inclusive in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
- 2 The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment
- 3 For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it

4 This Order is made on the day of 2009 and shall
come into operation on the day of 2009 and may be
cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Waiting Restrictions)
(No.W31) Order 2009"
