Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and in pursuance of the powers contained in Section 73 and Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to stop wait or otherwise leave the vehicle in a stationary manner between 8.15 am to 9.15 am and 3 pm to 4.30 pm on Monday to Friday inclusive in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
2. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment
3. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it

4. This Order is made on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 2009 and shall  
come into operation on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 2009 and may be  
cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Waiting Restrictions)  
(No.W5) Order 2009"

<b>ITEM NUMBER</b>	<b>COLUMN 1 NAME OF ROAD</b>	<b>COLUMN 2 LENGTH OF ROAD</b>
1.	CHURCH STREET WOODLESFORD	NORTH SIDE – from a point 18 metres west of the projected eastern kerblines of Highfield Lane in a westerly direction for a distance of 30 metres
2.	CHURCH STREET WOODLESFORD	SOUTH SIDE – from a point 5 metres east of the eastern kerblines of Highfield Lane in a westerly direction for a distance of 48 metres
3.	HIGHFIELD LANE WOODLESFORD	EAST SIDE – from the southern kerblines of Church Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 86 metres
4.	BEECHWOOD WOODLESFORD	EAST SIDE AT ITS WESTERN JUNCTION WITH CHURCH STREET – from the northern kerblines of Church Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 2 metres
