18 TONNE WEIGHT LIMITS

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

This order is proposed to bring existing restrictions up to date as the 17 tonne Weight Restrictions Orders which are currently in place are not permitted in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

Cemetery Road and Wesley Street in Beeston and the A58 in Wetherby and Monkwood all have 17 tonne orders which will be revoked and replaced with a single 18 tonne order for all four lengths.

**A58 WETHERBY ROAD/

18 TONNE WEIGHT LIMITS

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to:-

1. to prohibit vehicles exceeding 18 tonnes maximum gross weight from proceeding in the A58 Wetherby Road, Collingham (southbound only) from a point 30 metres east of its junction with Boston Road in a westerly and then south-westerly direction for a distance of 1975 metres;
2. to prohibit vehicles exceeding 18 tonnes maximum gross weight (other than vehicles requiring access to or egress from land or buildings adjacent to the lengths of road) in:-
 - (i) Wesley Street, Beeston, Leeds from its junction with Elland Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Town Street, Beeston;
 - (ii) Cemetery Road, Beeston, Leeds from its junction with Elland Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Tempest Road;
 - (iii) A58 Wetherby Road, Monkwood, Leeds from a point 33 metres south-west of its junction with the A6120 Ring Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 1133 metres.

Full details of the proposals in the form of a draft Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1, Beeston Library, Hugh Gaitskell School, St Anthony's Drive, Leeds 11 and at Wetherby Library, 17 Westgate, Wetherby.

18 TONNE WEIGHT LIMITS

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle exceeding 18 tonnes maximum gross weight to proceed in the length of road specified in First Schedule to this Order
2. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle exceeding 18 tonnes maximum gross weight other than a vehicle requiring access to or egress from land or buildings adjacent to the lengths of road to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Second Schedule to this Order
3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment

4. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it
5. This Order is made on the day of 2009 and shall come into force on the day of 2009 and shall be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Movement Restriction) (No.M23) Order 2008"
