

## **Find out about your local emergency services**

Make a record of your local emergency telephone numbers (National and local emergency services, council, electricity, gas, water etc – you will find these in your local phone book) and keep them near your phone.

Remember to dial 999 for police, fire and ambulance attendance during life or property threatening situations. When notifying the emergency services of your location, ensure you provide the exact street address and if possible, the nearest cross roads.
