

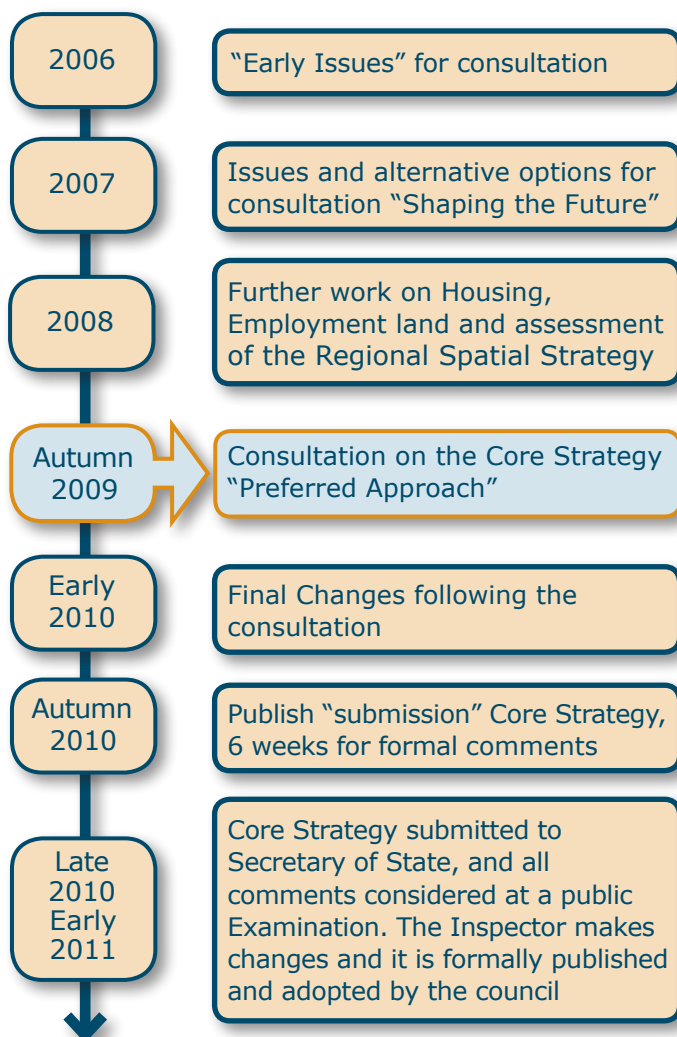

The Core Strategy is the principal document of the Local Development Framework (LDF). It is not the role of the Core Strategy to make site specific allocations for development but, within the context of the Community Strategy set an overall direction for regeneration, economic development and growth – linked to the principles of sustainable development.
