STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

During the consultation period for the previous order on Blackmoor Lane, implemented in March 2009 a request was received for the 30 mph speed limit to be extended to cover the caravan park entrance of 103 Blackmoor Lane. It was agreed at that time that we would implement the scheme and when it had settled down we would assess the possibility of extending the 30 mph limit past these entrances.

A survey was undertaken to assess the speeds of vehicles on this length of Blackmoor Lane and it is noted that the mean speeds were at or under 30 mph in each direction which would qualify for the speed limit to be reduced from 40 mph to 30 mph.

A 45 metre section of Spear Fir is proposed to be changed to a 30 mph speed limit from its junction with Blackmoor Lane to give drivers turning onto Spear Fir a better view of the change in speed limit.

Blackmoor Lane will therefore become a 30mph speed limit from its junction with Tithe Barn Lane/Church Lane to the entrance of the caravan park of 103 Blackmoor Lane, where it will then change to a 40mph speed limit until its junction with Tarn Lane/Syke Lane.

The new location for the speed limit change will maintain the road safety of the area.

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to amend the Leeds City Council (Speed Limit) (No.13) Order 2008 as follows:-

1. a 45 metre section of Syke Lane from its junction with Blackmoor Lane in a generally southerly direction will become 30 miles per hour;
2. Blackmoor Lane from its junction with Tithe Barn Lane/Church Lane to the entrance of the caravan park of 103 Blackmoor Lane will become 30 miles per hour.

Full details of the proposals in the form of a draft Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1 and at Wetherby Library, 17 Westgate, Wetherby.
