Neighbourhood Index Report

The city wide score for the Leeds Index of Neighbourhoods is 65.73 and across the Middle Super Output Areas the scores range from 30.05 in Beeston Hill to 92.45 in the Brownberries / West End area of Horsforth.

The following map shows the distribution of scores for the combined Leeds Neighbourhood Index. The least successful areas have the lowest combined scores and are shown in shades of purple. The most successful areas have the highest combined scores and are shown in shades of beige.

The less successful areas

The results of the initial Neighbourhood Index for Leeds show that the least successful areas are generally located in the Inner East and Inner South, with Chapeltown in the Inner North East, Armley / New Wortley in the Inner West and Halton Moor / Wykebecks in Outer East displaying similarly poor results.

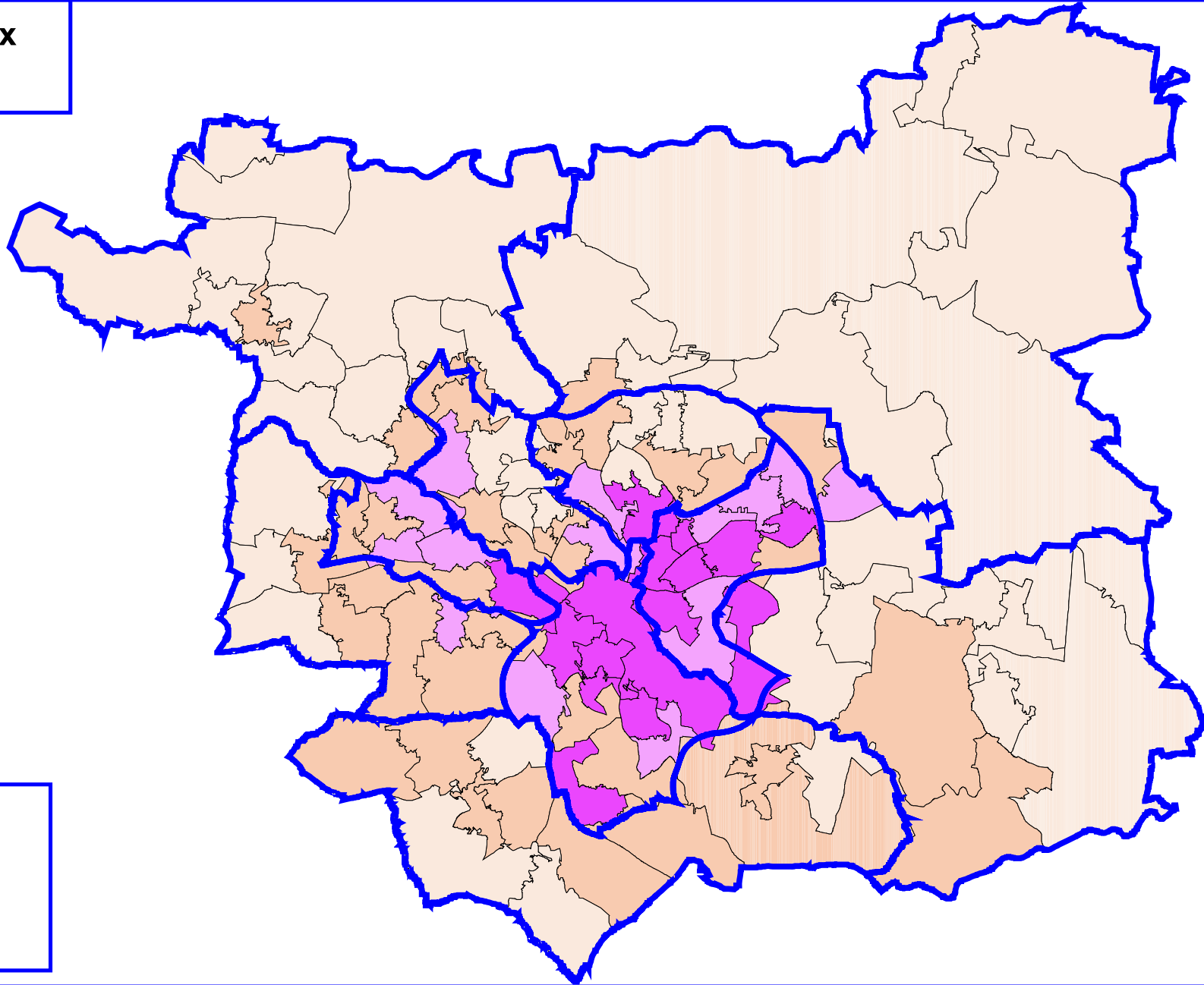
Typically these areas suffer high levels of crime, low educational attainment, poor health, low income levels and high levels of worklessness. In terms of housing and environment the results are more varied, but this insufficient to compensate for other aspects of deprivation.

These results broadly reflect evidence from elsewhere, particularly the Government's Index of Multiple Deprivation 2007, further demonstrating the complex nature of deprivation in these areas.

The more successful areas

The most successful areas are generally located in the Outer North West and Outer North East. Results for Outer West, Outer South and Outer East show most areas at average or better, the only exceptions being Farnley in Outer West together with Halton Moor / Wykebecks and Swarcliffe in Outer East.
