

OTHER DEPARTMENTS OF THE COUNCIL – WHAT GOES WHERE?

In the field of what many consider to be Anti-Social Behaviour, there are a number of Council departments who hold specific expertise and responsibilities aside from the Council's Anti-Social Behaviour Unit.

The following Leeds City Council Departments could possibly be of assistance with some aspects of anti-social behaviour or disputes between neighbours. This may also assist you in ensuring that you report your concerns to the relevant department:

Planning

This Department can consider (although as an independent arbiter) disputes involving:

- boundaries
- access rights to land/driveways etc
- high hedges/trees
- planning and business use of properties

Poorly repaired or derelict housing can also be dealt with by way of prosecutions from this department

Health and Environmental Action Service (HEAS)

- statutory nuisances (noise, lighting, alarms, smells)
- hazardous substances
- untidy and verminous properties and gardens
- fly-tipping
- burning of waste/rubbish
- dog control (fouling, on leashes and barking)
- graffiti removal from private property
- abandoned vehicles
- obstructions on the highway/footpath
- sale and repair of cars on the highway for business
- Houses of Multiple Occupation (HMO) Licensing
- Void properties
- Parking Enforcement
- inconsiderate parking can be looked at if this is a problem affecting the neighbourhood and might give rise to a Traffic Regulation Order
