20MPH SPEED LIMIT

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

Leeds City Council has identified the need to improve both pedestrian safety and the environment by reducing the impact of motor vehicles in the vicinity of the new bus station in Pudsey by introducing a 20mph speed limit on Market Place and Crawshaw Hill.

The proposed area to be covered by the speed limit includes Market Place which will form the circulatory route of the new bus station. Market Place also has shop fronts, and pedestrian access to the Market, the park and the leisure centre generating high pedestrian flows.

The speed limit will also include Crawshaw Hill which is a direct link from Market Place to Robin Lane. This street is extremely narrow and provides access to the leisure centre car park, the medical centre and care home. By including Crawshaw Hill in this order there is no change from 20 to 30mph at the junction of Market Place and Crawshaw Hill which is close to the main entrance of the leisure centre.

The overall effect of the introduction of this Order is to make the various users of the new bus station aware of the potential vehicle/pedestrian conflicts and allow the bus station to operate as safely as possible.

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”) and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with the persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order is made on the day of 2010 and shall come into force on the day of 2010 and may be cited as the “Leeds City Council (Speed Limit) (No 3) Order 2010”
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
