



## Language Exchange @ Central Library

### What is Language Exchange?

The Language Exchange scheme aims to help adult language learners to practise their new language skills. This can be between two native speakers or as part of a group that brings together native speakers and learners.

To be part of the Language Exchange at Leeds Central Library you will have to register with Europe Direct who are based in the Information Centre on the second floor. We will keep your data in our language exchange register and check if there is someone suitable for you to pair up with.

We will not share any of your details with others. Once a match has been found we will contact both parties individually and invite you to the next available session where you can meet each other and decide if you want to meet regularly at our sessions.

### Report disruptive behaviour

We will offer regular language exchange sessions in the library where you can meet your learning partner(s) in a public environment with library staff present. We want to achieve a positive and relaxed environment for language learning. Please inform the attending member of staff about any inappropriate, disruptive or abusive behaviour.

We cannot be responsible for what happens outside our sessions but recommend that you do not give out your address or personal details until you are ready.
