Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to introduce a one way traffic flow on Nags Lane, Wetherby, from its junction with Victoria Street in a northerly direction to its junction with Walton Road.

Full details of the proposal in the form of a draft Order together with a plan showing the affected section of highway and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1 and Wetherby Library, 17 Westgate, Wetherby, Leeds LS22 6LL.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

A recent highway scheme for Horsefair, Wetherby included revised traffic priorities at the junction of Hallfield Lane, Walton Road and Nags Lane. On opening, a road safety concern was raised when a number of drivers were seen approaching from Hallfield Lane and turning directly into Nags Lane without apparently looking left down Walton Road.

Following a successful trial between February and April 2009, a permanent one way order preventing vehicular traffic proceeding south along Nags Lane is proposed.

The Order will also:

- address the cause of property damage to the gable end of 2 Walton Road as a consequence of vehicles negotiating Nags Lane;
- reduce congestion at the exit on to Victoria Street;
- prevent large vehicles negotiating Nags Lane; and
- assist pedestrians walking along Nags Lane who will benefit from a reduction in traffic volumes.

ONE WAY TRAFFIC FLOW

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the First Schedule to this Order in any direction other than that specified in Column 2 of the First Schedule
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply if the vehicle is a mechanical road cleansing vehicle when being used for that purpose between 10.00pm and 6.00 am on Monday to Friday inclusive and between 7.30 am and 12.30 am on Sunday and Christmas day
3. The Order specified in Column 1 of the Second Schedule to this Order is hereby amended/revoked to the extent specified in Column 2 of the said Second Schedule
4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment

5. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it

6. This Order is made on the 11th day of June 2010 and shall come into force on the 14th day of June 2010 and shall be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Movement Restrictions) (No.M11) Order 2010"
