PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Leeds City Council has today made the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into effect on 21 June 2010 is to introduce a total prohibition of motor vehicles on Grange Terrace Chapel Allerton for a distance of 5.9 metres to its junction with Chapeltown Road.

A copy of the Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St. George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1 and Chapel Allerton Library 106 Harrogate Road LS7 4LZ.

If you wish to object to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained within it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not be complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date upon which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. For the purposes of this Order "**motor vehicle**" shall have the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act.
2. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order
3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment

REVOCATION

4. The Order specified in Column 1 of the Second Schedule to this Order is hereby amended/revoked to the extent specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the said Second Schedule

GENERAL

5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment
6. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road or a parking place shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road or parking place where the context requires it
7. This Order is made on the 18 day of June 2010 and shall come into effect on the 21 day of June 2010 and may be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Waiting Restrictions) (No.M05) Order 2010
