**MORRISON'S DEVELOPMENT, HAREHILLS
ASSOCIATED HIGHWAY WORKS**

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

The Order is being promoted in connection with a proposed new superstore development by Morrisons. The associated highway works include a new traffic signal-controlled junction between the proposed access road to the superstore and Harehills Lane.

The existing junction of Chatsworth Road with Harehills Lane is located close to the proposed traffic signal-controlled junction. To enable safe operation of the proposed junction to take place, it is necessary to prohibit vehicles turning into and out of Chatsworth Road.

As a result, Chatsworth Road will become a cul-de-sac. As part of the associated highway works, a turning head is proposed on Chatsworth Road adjacent to the point closure.

MORRISONS DEVELOPMENT HAREHILLS LANE LEEDS

Leeds City Council has today made the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into effect on 2 August 2010 will be :-

1. A prohibition of motor vehicles on Chatsworth Road from its junction with Harehills Lane in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
2. No waiting at any time on sections of Harehills Lane, Berkeley Road, Berkeley Grove, Berkeley Terrace, Berkeley Mount, Chatsworth Road, Darfield Road and the Unnamed Access Road to the Superstore.
3. Waiting limited to 2 hours with no return within 2 hours between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Monday to Saturday inclusive (other than permit holders) on the south west side of Harehills Lane from a point 17 metres north west of the junction with Ashley Road to a point 3 metres north west of the junction with Berkeley Road adjacent to 224 to 254 Harehills Lane.
4. Residents Permit Parking for residents of 212 to 254 Harehills Lane.
5. No stopping at any time on the school entrance markings on the west side of Darfield Road from a point 28 metres southwest of the junction with Harehills Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of 70 metres.

A copy of the Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St. George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1.

If you wish to object to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained within it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not be complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date upon which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

**MORRISONS DEVELOPMENT HAREHILLS LANE LEEDS
PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES**

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. For the purposes of this Order "**motor vehicle**" shall have the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act.
2. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment
5. This Order is made on the 30 day of July 2010 and shall come into force on the 2 day of August 2010 and shall be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Movement Restriction) (No.M12) Order 2009"
