STATEMENT OF REASONS

The car park adjacent to Pudsey Civic Hall is currently used for contract parking by commuters working in the area for which a charge is made. In addition, it is also used for indiscriminate commuter parking by other drivers who are not currently required to make any payment. The introduction of pay and display parking will deter usage by those who do not wish to pay and free up spaces for other users. In doing so it will secure the provision of suitable and adequate off street parking facilities.

AMENDMENT OF EXISTING ORDER

PUDSEY CIVIC HALL

Leeds City Council has today made the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into effect on 2 August 2010 is to amend the Leeds City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2010 by introducing pay and display parking at Pudsey Civic Hall in the interests of providing suitable and adequate off street parking facilities.

A copy of the Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St. George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1 and at Pudsey Library, Church Lane, Pudsey, Leeds, LS28 7TY.

If you wish to object to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained within it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not be complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date upon which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1, 2, 32, 33, 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and in pursuance of the powers contained in Section 73 and Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Leeds City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2010 shall have effect as though the off-street parking place described in the Schedule to this Order was included in the First Schedule of the said Consolidation Order.

2. This Order is made on the 30 day of July 2010 and shall come into force on the 2 day of August 2010 and shall be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2010 (Amendment) (No.2) Order 2010
