ADOPTION STATEMENT

The Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) for the Headingley & Hyde Park Neighbourhood Design Statement was adopted by Leeds City Council on 17 September 2010. The Headingley & Hyde Park Neighbourhood Design Statement SPD describes, analyses and evaluates the design of the environment of Headingley Ward and adjacent parts of Hyde Park & Woodhouse Ward.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
