

WEST LEEDS GATEWAY SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT (SPD)

ADOPTION STATEMENT

The Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) for West Leeds Gateway was adopted by Leeds City Council on 13th October 2010. The West Leeds Gateway SPD aims to support the regeneration of this part of west Leeds and to guide the determination of planning applications.

The area of the SPD includes Armley, Wortley, New Wortley and The Heights area. It stretches from the Armley Gytratory to The Heights and includes Wortley Recreation Ground, Armley Park, Armley Town Centre, the Industrial Museum at Armley Mills and the Leeds-Liverpool Canal.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
