# From **Friday 1 April 2011** a **50p fare** will be introduced on the Leeds CityBus.

It has been necessary to introduce a fare due to public sector budget reductions. Use of the service will be assessed over the coming months before a decision on its long-term future is made.

Customers holding one of the following passes or tickets will **continue to travel free** on the service:

- ▶ **MetroDay.**
- ▶ **MetroCards** (all types).
- ▶ **Metro Blind Concessionary Pass.**
- ▶ **West Yorkshire DayRovers\***.
- ▶ **English National Concessionary Scheme Senior and Disabled passes\*.**
- ▶ **PlusBus tickets to/from Leeds.**
- ▶ **First tickets** such as FirstDay and FirstStudent.
- ▶ **Day and season tickets issued by other bus operators** such as Arriva, Centrebus, Geldards or Transdev.

The Leeds CityBus timetable will be unchanged, running few minutes from 0630 to 1930, Mondays to Saturdays only. For more information:
