ADOPTION STATEMENT

The Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) for the Little Woodhouse Neighbourhood Design Statement was adopted by Leeds City Council on 22nd March 2011. The Little Woodhouse Neighbourhood Design Statement SPD describes, analyses and evaluates the design of the environment of parts of the Hyde Park and Woodhouse, Headingley and City Centre and Hunslet Wards.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
