PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS

NORTH PARKWAY SEACROFT LEEDS

Leeds City Council has today made the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which come into effect on 27 June 2011 is to prohibit traffic from making right turns on various sections of North Parkway, Seacroft in both directions.

A copy of the Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal Services Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St. George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1 and at Seacroft Library, Seacroft Crescent, Leeds, LS14 6PA.

If you wish to object to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained within it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not be complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date upon which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

NORTH PARKWAY SEACROFT LEEDS

PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS

1. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the First Schedule to this Order to make a right turn into the lengths of road specified in Column 2 of the said First Schedule

2. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment

GENERAL


3. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it

4. This Order is made on the 24th day of June 2011 and shall come into effect of the 27th day of June 2011 and may be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Movement Restrictions) (No.M20) Order 2010
