LINCOLN ROAD & ACCOMMODATION ROAD BURMANTOFTS

PROHIBITION RIGHT & LEFT TURNS

Leeds City Council has today made the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into effect on 10 January 2011 will be to introduce :-

1. A prohibited right turn from Lincoln Green Road into Beckett Street
2. A prohibited left turn from Accommodation Road into Beckett Street

A copy of the Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St. George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1 and at Richmond Hill Library Pontefract Lane LS9 9AH.

If you wish to object to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained within it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not be complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date upon which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

PROHIBITED RIGHT & LEFT TURNS

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

The measures proposed by this Order are to be introduced under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984,. Their intention is to eliminate the risk of accidents considered to be directly attributable to dangerous manoeuvres from Lincoln Green Road and Accommodation Road into Beckett Street and improve the free flow of traffic through the junction.

A large number of accidents have been recorded at the signalised junction of Lincoln Green Road, Beckett Street and Accommodation Road that are directly related to right turning traffic. Traffic surveys at this junction have found that traffic wishing to turn right from Lincoln Green Road to Beckett Street cause a direct obstruction to oncoming traffic. In the interests of public safety it is therefore proposed to prohibit this manoeuvre together with the left turn manoeuvre from Accommodation Road to Beckett Street.

PROHIBITED RIGHT & LEFT TURNS

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

PROHIBITED RIGHT & LEFT TURNS

1. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the First Schedule to this Order to make a right turn into the length of road specified in Column 2 of the said First Schedule

2. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the Second Schedule to this Order to make a left turn into the length of road specified in Column 2 of the said Second Schedule

GENERAL

3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment

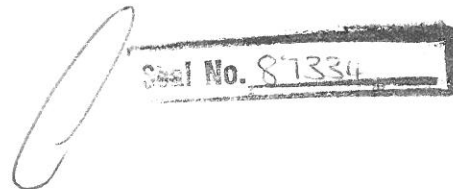
4. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it

5. This Order is made on the 7 day of January 2011 and shall come into force on the 10 day of January 2011 and shall be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Movement Restrictions) (No.M14) Order 2010"
