The winner will also light the Bonfire & Fireworks display with local dignitaries on the night.

The Winner and Runners-up will receive individual Certificates acknowledging their success.

The Winner will receive £100 worth of Gardening Vouchers for their school.

Runners-up will each receive £50 worth of Gardening Vouchers for their Schools.

The Winner and runners up all receive a quality art Set.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- There are to be three categories which are: Key Stage 1 – Key Stages 3 & 4 – Key Stages 5 & 6.
- The competition will be open to all schools in the South Leeds Area.
- The idea is to design a poster that best reflects bonfire night and fireworks which can then be used to promote the bonfire event at Middleton Park.
- Individual entries only, no shared or group designs.
- Each design must be no larger than A3 and be clearly labelled with the Title of the Design; Child's Full Name, Age, along with the Schools Name, Address & Telephone number.
- Leeds City Council and The White Rose Centre will appoint judges whose decision is final. No correspondence concerning the competition will be entered into thereafter.
- Leeds City Council reserves the right to display or reproduce any of the designs without seeking the individual's permission.
- All entries will be returned to their owners after the competition. Any design, which does not comply with the rules, will be disqualified.
