

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE A
GATING ORDER**

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 129A

**LEEDS CITY COUNCIL (GATING ORDER NO. 3) 2011
GRAFTON VILLAS LONG FOOTPATH, CROSSGATES, LEEDS 14**

Leeds City Council (“the Council”), propose to make an Order under section 129A of the Highways Act 1980, as the Council is satisfied that to prevent or reduce crime and anti-social behaviour from occurring in the area it is necessary to gate and fence Grafton Villas Long Footpath, Crossgates, Leeds.

An alternative route for public use is available along Pendas Way turning right into Kelmscott Lane.

Access to the Grafton Villas Long Footpath will be restricted at all times.

The intended restriction applies to any person wishing to use this footpath. Keys to the gated areas will be allocated to those adjacent occupiers of property adjoining the footpath who reasonably require access.

The contact details of the organisation which is responsible for maintaining any gates authorised by the intended order is Leeds Community Safety, 2nd Floor, Leeming House, Vicar Lane, Leeds LS2 7JF where further details are available justifying the intended gating of the named footpaths.

Any person aggrieved by the making of an intended gating order should make representations, in writing, to Ken Bell, Development Section, Leeds City Council, St George House, Great George Street, Leeds LS1 3DL (quoting reference A76/KB/869917), not later than 28 days from the date of this notice.
