STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

The Hawksworth estate is a large residential estate in Kirkstall of around 1300 properties; a primary school is also located within the estate. A number of recorded injury accidents have occurred on roads within the estate over the last five year period, particularly on a known through route for vehicular traffic.

To address these accidents and promote an environment more appropriate for the residential nature of the area, it is proposed to create a 20mph Zone within the estate.

It is also proposed to implement 20MPH speed limits on a number of roads within two adjacent areas being the Vespers and those around and including Spen Approach. A 20MPH speed limit would similarly provide a more suitable residential environment, and encourage motorists to drive at a speed appropriate for the geometry of the roads.

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the First and Second Schedules to this Order
2. This Order is made on the day of 2011 and shall come into force on the day of 2011 and may be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Speed Limit) (No.12) Order 2010"

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to introduce:

- 1) a 20 miles per hour Speed Limit Zone on the full lengths of roads in the Hawsworth Estate and;
- 2) a 20 miles per hour speed limit on the full lengths of roads in the Vespers and Spen Approach areas of Kirkstall, Leeds.

Full details of the proposals in the form of a draft Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1 and at Headingley Library, North Lane, Headingley, Leeds LS6 3HG.
