How much can you apply for

Leeds Inspired welcomes applications between £1,000 and £15,000. However, in exceptional circumstances we will consider bids over £15,000. If this applies to you, please call Jane Earnshaw, Leeds Inspired Coordinator on 0752 838 3910 to discuss your application.

When you can apply

There will be two calls for Leeds Inspired grant applications and the deadlines are: **20th January 2012** and **20th March 2012**.

Duration of grant

Applications can be made for short-term activities (e.g. a festival or exhibition) happening within the grant year, or for longer-term work where the main event may happen in 3 years time because planning and development is required. However, a grant for development activities does not automatically lead to approval for subsequent years' work. All grants are subject to funds being available.
