## How do I know which Apprenticeship Level to choose?

If your job role involves the following ...

Description of Job Role	Apprenticeship Level	Equivalent Qualification
A range of tasks which include a variety of work activities, most of which are routine and predictable – then you will be able to undertake a Level 1	1	5 GCSEs at Grade D – G (QCF Level 1)
A range of tasks including work activities performed in a variety of contexts. Some of which can be complex and non-routine and require some personal responsibility and evidence of team-work / collaboration with others – then you will be able to undertake a Level 2	2* Apprenticeship	5 GCSEs at Grade A* – C (QCF Level 2)
A range of tasks including work activities performed in a variety of contexts most of which are complex and non-routine; requiring considerable responsibility including the supervision or line management of others – then you will be able to undertake a Level 3	3* Advanced Apprenticeship	2 A levels (QCF Level 3)
A range of tasks including complex, technical or professional work activities, performed in a variety of contexts and with a substantial degree of personal responsibility for the allocation of resources – then you will be able to undertake a Level 4	4 Higher Apprenticeship	HNC / HND Foundation Degree (QCF Level 4)
A range of fundamental principles across a wide variety of contexts. Substantial, significant personal responsibility for the work of others, including the allocation of substantial resources. In addition personal accountabilities for analysis, diagnosis, planning, execution and evaluation – then you will be able to undertake a Level 5	5	Degree (QCF Level 5)
