BANNED RIGHT AND LEFT TURN FROM LITTLE NEVILLE STREET**

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

Leeds City Council has identified the need to improve the pedestrian crossing facilities in vicinity of the Neville Street and sovereign street junction. At present junction lacks pedestrian crossing facilities.

It is proposed to introduce straight controlled crossings to the northern and southern sides of the Neville Street with new dropped crossing points with tactile paving, and new signals with pedestrian crossing facilities (red/green man). In addition new central refuge island at the mouth of Sovereign Street with new dropped crossings with tactile paving will also be provided. The proposed new arrangement of junction can only be achieved by introducing obligatory left turn on Sovereign street whilst banned right and left turn on Little Neville Street.

The proposed layout of junction would reduce the pedestrian severance by reducing the potential pedestrian accident risk due to the existing high volume of traffic on Neville Street.

TRAFFIC MOVEMENT RESTRICTIONS

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 in relation to Leeds Arena the effect of which will be to:-

1. Prohibit vehicles proceeding in an easterly direction on Little Neville Street from turning either left or right onto Neville Street (north or south bound).
2. Introduce an mandatory left turn into Neville Street (south bound) for vehicles proceeding along Sovereign Street in a westerly direction.

Full details of the proposals in the form of a draft Order together with plan showing the affected sections of highway and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal Services Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St George House, Great George Street, Leeds

TRAFFIC MOVEMENT RESTRICTIONS

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales)

Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. For the purposes of this Order

"civil enforcement officer" means a person authorised by the Council to supervise any parking place

2. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the First Schedule to this Order to make a left turn into the length of road specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the said First Schedule
3. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the Second Schedule to this Order to make a right turn into the length of road specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the said Second Schedule

- 4 Save upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer every person causing a vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the Third Schedule to this Order shall cause that vehicle on reaching the road referred to in Column 2 of the said Third Schedule to make a left turn into Column 3 of the said Third Schedule
5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment
6. This Order is made on the day of 2012 and shall come into force on the
 day of 2012 and shall be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Movement Restriction) (No.M04) Order 2012"
