Leeds City Museum Central Arena

Leeds City Museum is a grade II listed building which was transformed into a state-of-the-art museum in September 2008

The impressive Central Arena, the focal point of the museum, is the largest space in the museum and can be used for a variety of events including presentations, dinners, and conferences

Located on the ground floor, the Arena is able to seat up to 250 people for a dinner event and can accommodate an audience of up to 400 for a presentation, 300 in the main arena and 100 upstairs on the balcony

There are five screens in the Arena. The centre screen can be used for powerpoint presentations with the other four showing film footage, logos or photographs etc





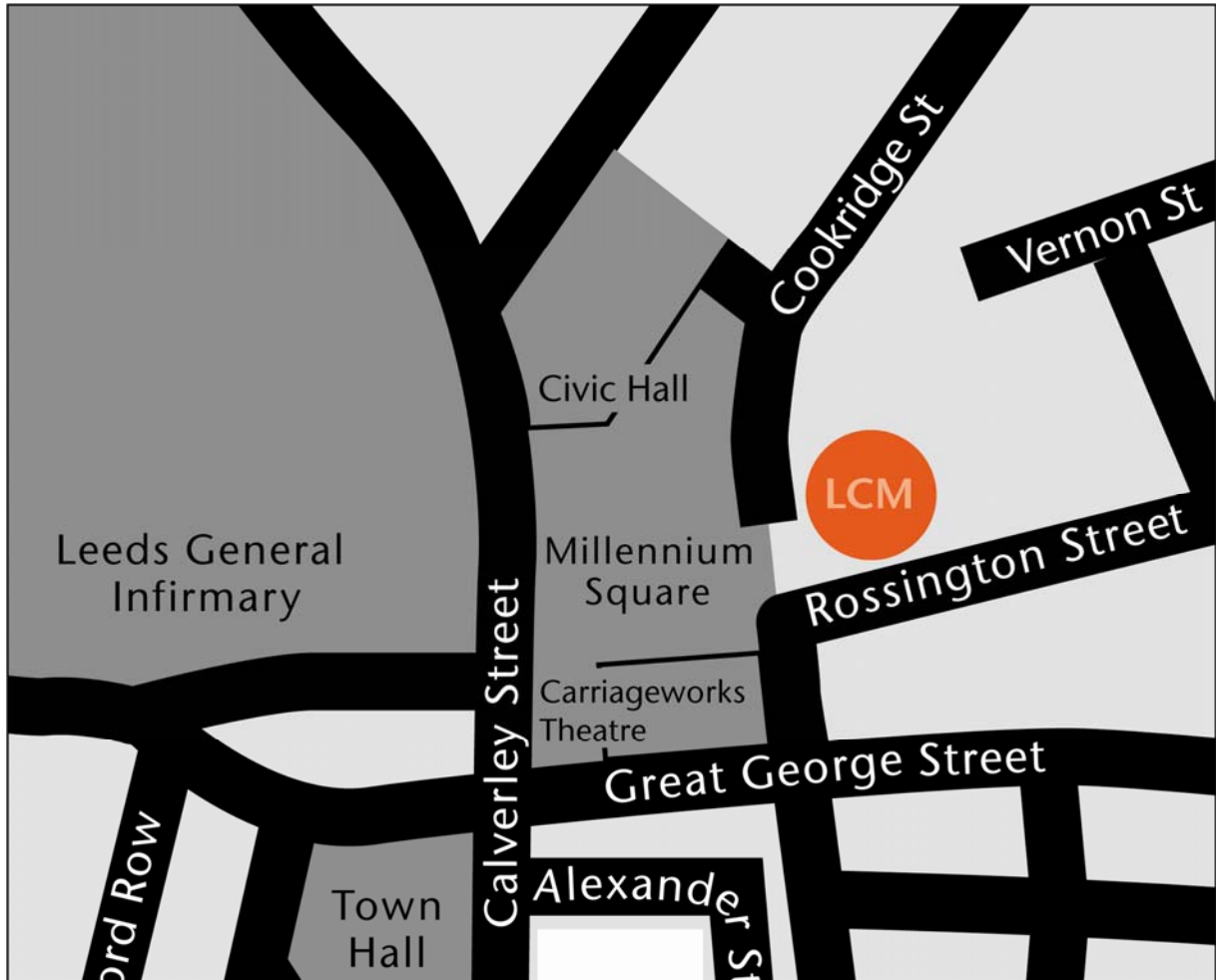
Leeds City Museum Conference Rooms

The Conference Suite is located on the lower ground floor. Both Denny and Thoresby Rooms are spacious rooms with natural daylight, AV facilities and free internet access

The Denny Room will accommodate up to 60 theatre style, 24 boardroom, 18 U-shape and 35 cabaret. The room is equipped with screen, data projector, laptop, TV and DVD/VCR

The Thoresby Room will accommodate up to 90 theatre style, 32 boardroom, 26 U-shape and 60 cabaret. The room is equipped with interactive whiteboard, screen, data projector, laptop and DVD. PA system and microphones are available





The City Museum is approximately 2 miles from the M62 (J3), 7 miles from Leeds Bradford Airport and 1/2 mile from Leeds City Station.

The Education Room

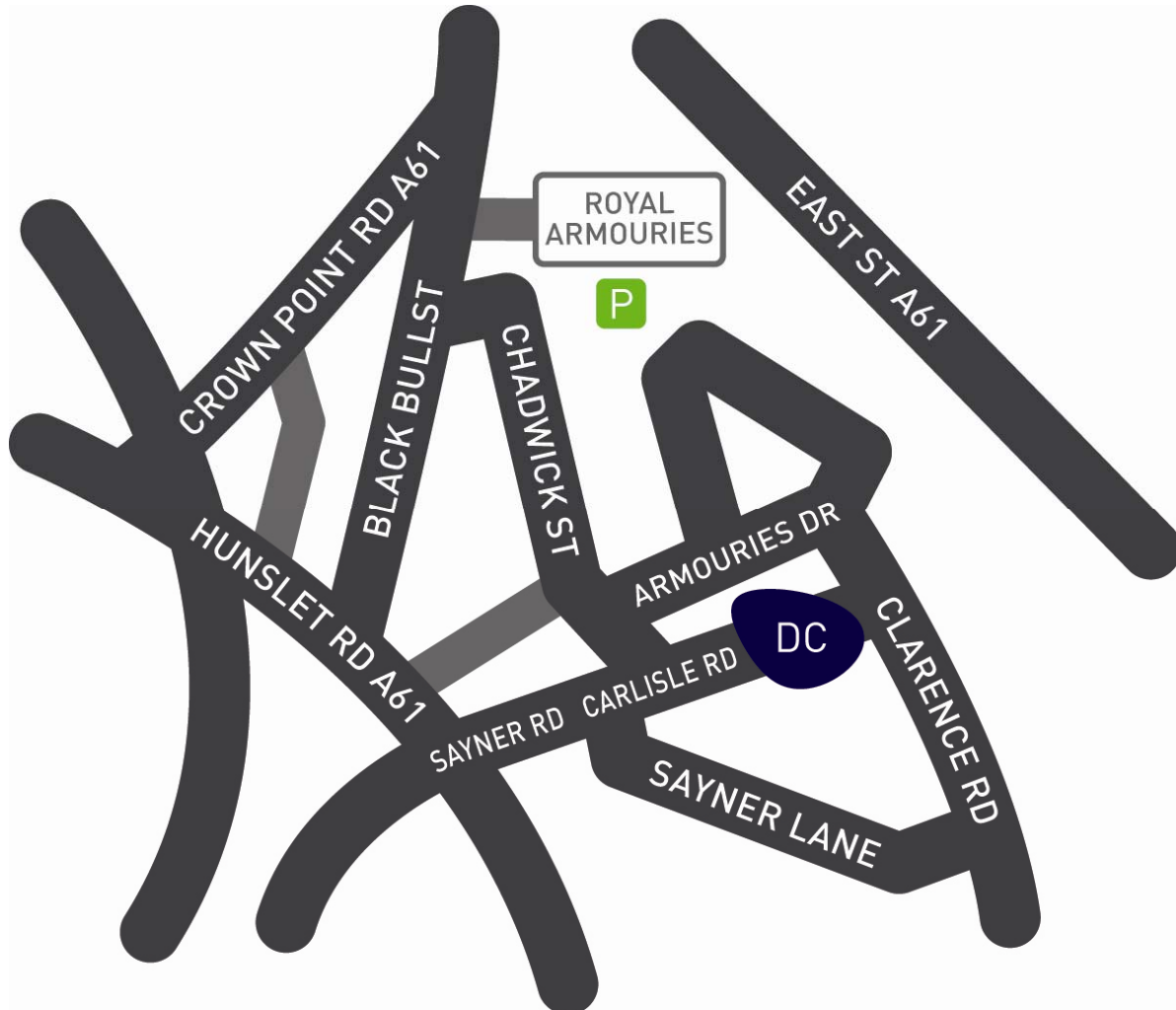
A bright modern feel with flexible layout, this space can be one large room or two smaller rooms.

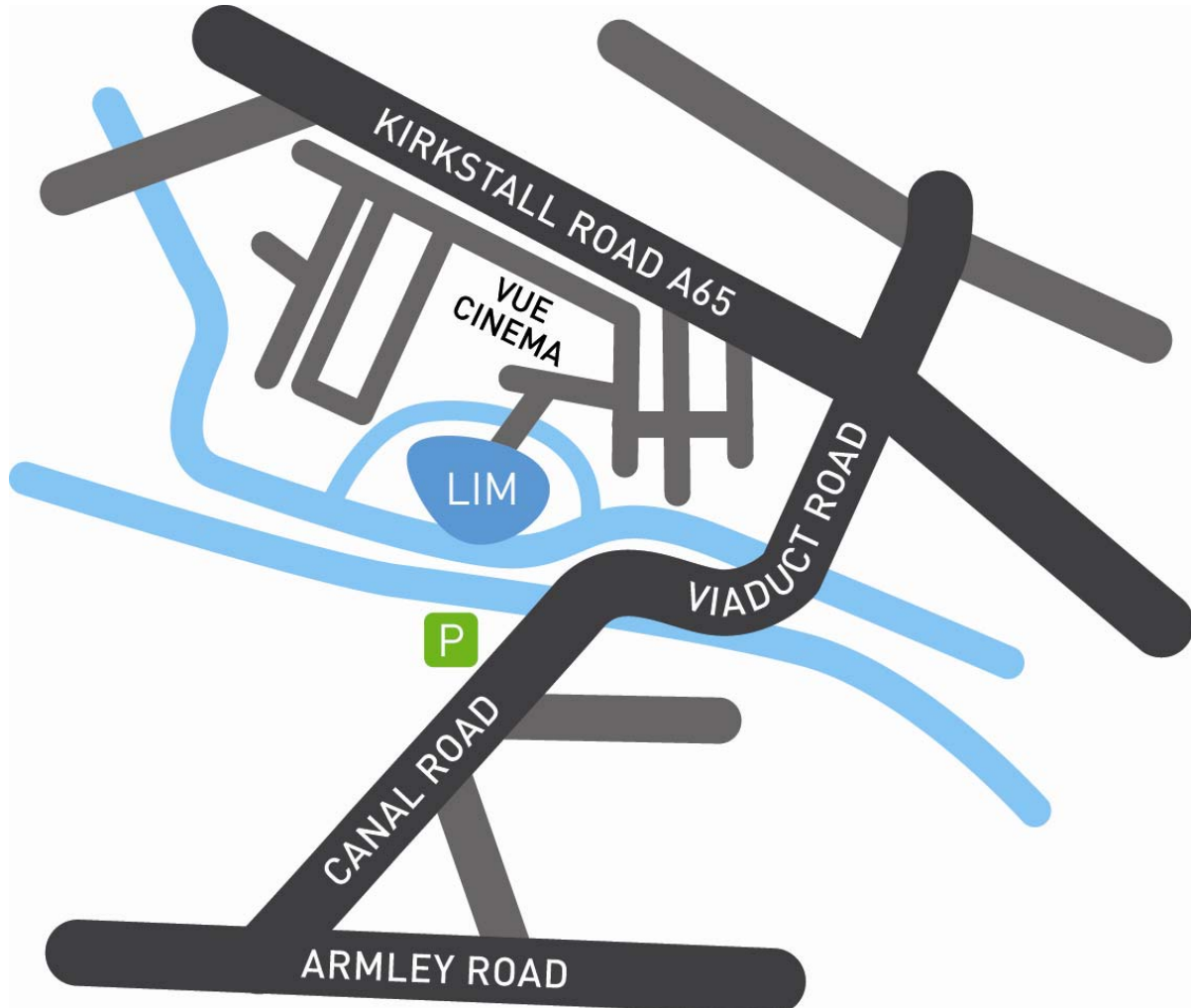

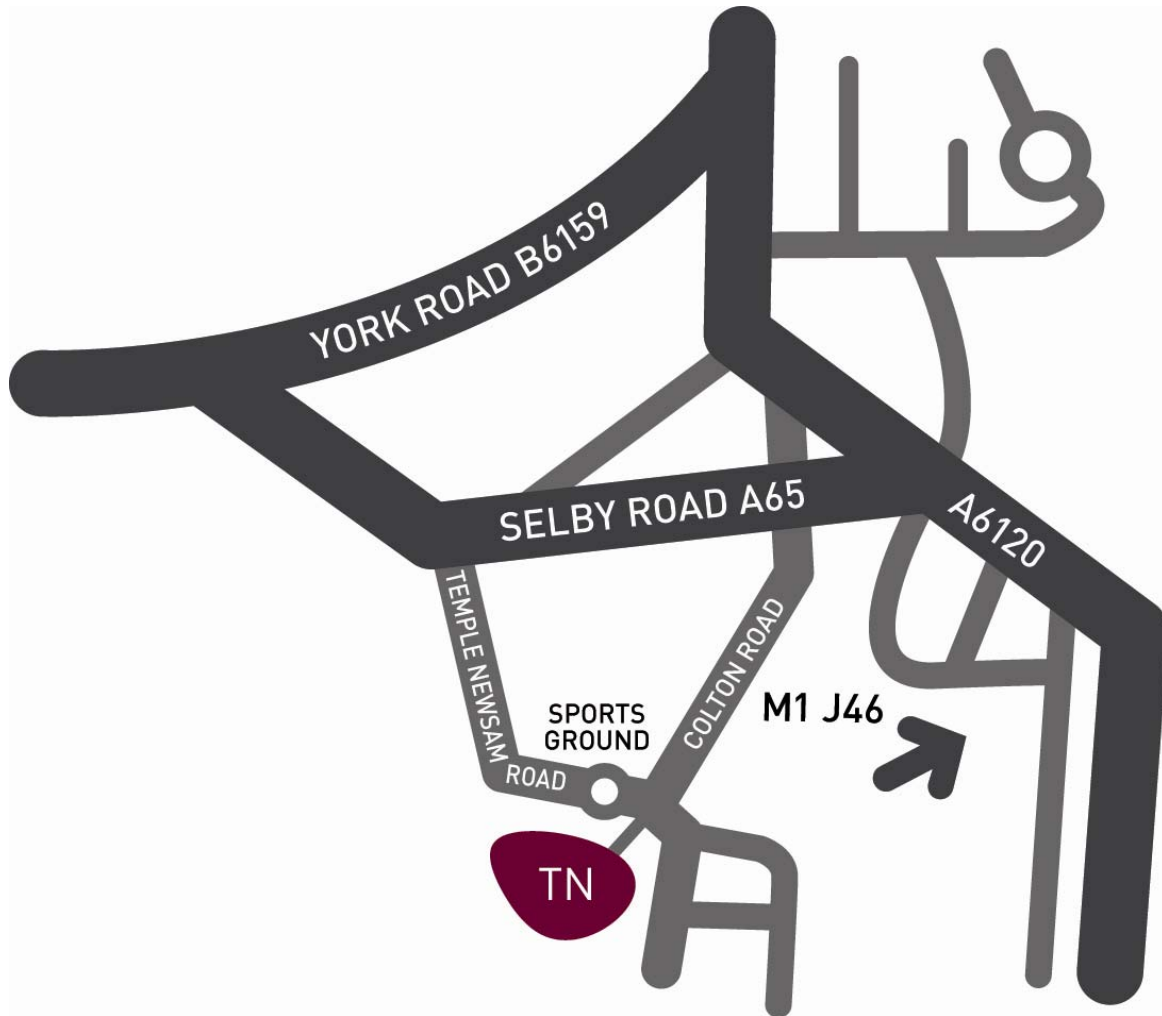

Leeds Art Gallery Conference Suite

The old lecture theatre in the Leeds Art Gallery has undergone a major refurbishment converting the space into a brand new conference suite with three ground floor rooms and one upstairs mezzanine room.

The **Henry Moore Room** will seat a maximum of 120 theatre style and 72 cabaret and 28 U- shape and is equipped with a cinema style 16.9 aspect ratio projection screen. The space can be used for a variety of event including conferences, receptions and dinners.



The **Hepworth Room** will seat a maximum of 14 boardroom and 12 cabaret and is equipped with a 40" LCD screen.



The **Inchbold Room** on the mezzanine floor will seat a maximum of 16 boardroom and 12 cabaret and is equipped with a 40" LCD screen. There is no disabled access to this room.



The **Wadsworth Room** will seat a maximum of 8 boardroom or 6 cabaret and is equipped with a 40" LCD screen.

Air conditioning is available throughout at no extra cost.
