*Within the Leeds Metropolitan District we have a statutory duty to monitor demolition work to ensure that 'Public Health and Safety' is maintained, and this service is fully undertaken by the Building Control Services. We therefore supervise and regulate the majority of demolition sites to ensure buildings are demolished safely and in accordance with the relevant standards laid out in Sections 80 and 82 of the Building Act 1984.

Following a review of the demolition application process, a charge of £200 will apply when making an application. This will cover both the administrative and professional costs in registering, notifying interested parties and assessing the accompanying health and safety documentation as well as any necessary site inspections to ensure the work is completed satisfactorily.
