ADOPTION STATEMENT
STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (SCI)

In accordance with Regulation 24 (4) and Regulation 36 of the Town & Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 notice is given that on 21st February 2007 Leeds City Council formally adopted its Statement of Community Involvement (SCI).

The SCI forms part of the Leeds Local Development Framework (LDF). The LDF will establish a spatial vision for future development and use of land, and once adopted will replace the Leeds Unitary Development Plan.

The SCI sets out how local people and others will be involved in the preparation of planning documents which form part of the LDF and how the community will be involved in the consideration of planning applications. It applies to the whole of the Leeds administrative area.

The SCI and a copy of this Adoption Statement are available for public inspection at the Development Enquiry Centre, Development Department, Leonardo Building, 2 Rossington Street, Leeds LS2 8HD (Monday-Friday 8.30 am – 5 pm, except Wednesday 9.30 am – 5 pm) and at all Leeds City Council libraries and One Stop Centres.

Any person aggrieved by the Council's SCI may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SCI. Any application to the High Court must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the 21st February 2007.
