### Wellbeing Grant

Applications are accepted throughout the year subject to funding being available. Deadline is 3 weeks prior to the Community Committee meetings. The next Committee is on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2018 so the deadline will be 12<sup>th</sup> February 2018

Priorities for 2017 are –

- Working together to support vulnerable adults and recognise the challenges they face
- Delivering actions to support children and young people and giving them the opportunity to have their say with decision makers
- Helping to make our neighbourhoods safer and improve transport links
- Agreeing and overseeing actions helping to make our neighbourhoods cleaner and greener.

### Youth activity funding

Funding applications will be accepted in February 2018 for projects over summer 2018 but no date has been set. The funding round will close in early April but no date has been set.

In January each year the Outer North West Community Committee hold a Young People's Voice event where young people from schools in the area (last year over 100 young people attend from 30 schools) are asked about what sort of projects they would like to see funded through YAF. Young people in the ONW would like projects to be -

- Fun and exciting
- Sporty/active
- Creative (dance and arts)
- Outside/ nature
- A chance to meet new people
- Inclusive and accessible

Therefore the Committee will prioritise projects which will deliver this for young people.
