

The draft Kippax Neighbourhood Plan is due to be submitted for independent examination shortly. In light of the EU Court of Justice Judgement in 'People over Wind' dated 12 April 2018, the Council has agreed to re-consider HRA Screening reports for Neighbourhood Plans, consult Natural England as the Statutory Consultee, and update the HRA Screening as appropriate.

Please see attached the Council's draft update to the HRA Screening of November 2016 which proposes that the screening is legally-compliant given that no LSEs were identified, therefore no 'mitigation' measures were considered.
