

Leeds City Council Learners fee 2017/18

Courses are free if you are in receipt of benefits or £3.00 per hour waged or 80p per hour for learners in receipt of state pension.

Fee exempt (no charge)

Learners attending the following **courses** are fee exempt:

- Courses where the main aim is English or Maths
- Family English, Maths and Language courses
- Wider Family Learning courses

Learners in receipt of the following income based state benefits are fee exempt:

- Job Seekers Allowance (JSA)
- Employment and Support Allowance
- Universal Credit
- Income support
- Incapacity Benefit
- Housing Benefit
- Council Tax Benefit(low income households)
- Working Tax credit
- Pension Credit
- Return to Work Credit
- In Work Credit
- Carers Allowance

Learners who fall into one of the following categories are Fee Exempt

- An offender serving their sentence in the Community.
- An Asylum Seeker in receipt of the equivalent of an income based state benefit.
- The unwaged dependant of an Asylum Seeker.
- An individual who is economically inactive because they are unable to claim income related state benefits.
- An individual suffering hardship

Check with the course providers for details on course fees and evidencing fee exemption.
