


How do I access your service?



Referrals can be made by a GP, Support Worker, Housing officer or other professional. Due to high demand we can no longer accept self-referrals.

What support is available?



The team helps people to decide what support is needed to improve any aspect of their life including housing applications, finding furniture, setting up utility bills and signposting for welfare benefits, education and employment.

We offer face-to-face and phone support for an agreed amount of time, which is usually around an hour a week.

How long does it last?

The team aims to help you to find and settle into your own accommodation in the community. We will also arrange longer-term housing support with other services if needed.

How do I get there?

Where possible we aim to visit you wherever you are currently staying. We can also arrange to meet you in a public place in the community if this is safer or more convenient.

How much does it cost?

The service is free for everyone who meets the eligibility criteria. We will also assist you to apply for any benefits or grants that you may be entitled to for help with renting and furnishing your new home.

What is the MHHT?

The Mental Health Homeless Team (MHHT) provides a dedicated floating support service for people who are faced with homelessness and who also have mental health problems.



Although we don't have any properties of our own, we can help with:

- making applications for **social housing** and **private landlords**,
- **viewing properties**,
- **sign up** and **settling in**, as well as
- **linking to other support services**.

Eligibility


We may be able to help if you are:

- **experiencing long and enduring mental health issues,**
- **have accessed mental health support or mental health services within the last 6 months.**



and you are also:

- **living on the streets**
- **lodging with family or friends**
- **sofa surfing**
- **living in emergency accommodation**



or

- **you have been told to leave by your landlord**
